ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 10, 2011, Administrative Law Judge Carla L. Garrett (ALJ Garrett), of the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), issued an Order to Show Cause Re: Dismissal (OSC) for Student's apparent failure to participate, prosecute, or advance the above-captioned matter. Specifically, on January 10, 2011, Student failed to participate in a scheduled prehearing conference (PHC) in this matter, despite ALJ Garrett's multiple attempts to convene the conference. In addition, Student failed to file a PHC statement, despite calls made by OAH staff on January 4, and 7, 2011, requesting Student to do so. ALJ Garrett set a telephonic OSC hearing for the January 12, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

On January 12, 2011, ALJ Garrett convened the OSC hearing. Student's father (Father) appeared on Student's behalf, and Donald Erwin, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Los Angeles Unified School District (District). Father advised that Student and her mother no longer resided in the United States, and requested that the matter be dismissed.

For good cause shown, this matter is dismissed. All dates are vacated.
