ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
MED/PHC/HRG

On March 4, 2011, the parties filed a stipulated request for a continuance to dates certain in the near future. The parties mistakenly thought that OAH was requesting to move the hearing dates to accommodate OAH training, when in fact, OAH merely wanted to reschedule the prehearing conference to a date other than March 21, 2011. A telephonic hearing on the continuance request was held on March 9, 2011, at which time the parties clarified that they understood OAH was not requesting a continuance. The parties then made a joint request for a continuance on the ground that a short continuance could lead to resolution of the issues through settlement.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332 .) .)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is GRANTED. The PHC and Hearing dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Mediation:	3/17/11 at 9:30 AM
Prehearing Conference:	4/4/11 at 1:30 PM
Due Process Hearing:	4/13,14, 18-21/11 at 9:30 AM, except 4/18/11 at 1:00 PM.
