ORDER VACATING HEARING  
DATES AND SETTING STATUS  
CONFERENCE

On May 16, 2011, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Charles Marson, Office of Administrative Hearings. Christian M. Knox, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Paul Gant, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Marysville Joint Union School District (District). The PHC was not recorded.

The parties represented that they have signed a settlement agreement that is contingent upon approval by the District's Board, which is expected to approve the agreement at its meeting on May 23, 2011, and that the only reason they have not filed notice of the agreement is because Parent has placed the signed agreement in the U.S. Mail.

Good cause appearing, the dates for the due process hearing are vacated. A status conference is set for June 8, 2011, at 1:30 p.m. If the settlement is approved, the parties shall promptly notify OAH and Student shall file a dismissal.
