ORDER GRANTING DISTRICT'S  
MOTION TO DISMISS ISSUE A

On November 24, 2010, the San Francisco Unified School District (District) filed a Request for Due Process (complaint) naming Student as respondent. District's complaint included two issues. The first issue, Issue A, concerned FAPE issues related to the 2010-2011 school year, as well as the extended school year for 2010. The second issue, Issue B, concerned the appropriateness of psychoeducational and speech and language assessments.

On November 29, 2010, District filed a request to dismiss, without prejudice, Issue A of its complaint. Accordingly, Issue A is hereby withdrawn.

ORDER

District's Motion to Dismiss Issue A, without prejudice, is granted. The matter will proceed as scheduled as to Issue B.
