ORDER GRANTING JOINT REQUEST
FOR CONTINUANCE AND SETTING
MED/PHC/HRG

On May 5, 2011, Student and the Glendale Unified School District (District), filed a joint request to continue the dates in this matter.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3).) Speedy resolution of the due process hearing is mandated by law and continuance of the hearing may be granted only upon a showing of good cause. (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f)(3).) In ruling upon a motion for continuance, OAH is guided by the provisions found within the Administrative Procedure Act and the California Rules of Court that concern motions to continue. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is granted. Parties should not expect any further continuances. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Mediation:	June 28, 2011 at 9:30 a.m.
Prehearing Conference:	August 29, 2011 at 1:30 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	September 6, 7, 8, and 12, 2011. Please note that OAH does not calendar Friday hearing dates. On September 6 and 12, 2011, the hearing shall begin at 1:30 p.m. On all other days, the hearing shall begin at 9:30 a.m.
