ORDER FOLLOWING TRIAL
SETTING CONFERENCE, AND
SETTING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND DUE PROCESS
HEARING

On March 16, 2011, a telephonic trial setting conference (TSC) was held before Administrative Law Judge Bob N. Varma, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Parent appeared on behalf of Student. Laurie Reynolds, attorney at law, appeared on behalf of the New Haven Unified School District (District)

The complaint in this matter was filed on January 4, 2011. A continuance was granted on February 22, 2011. On February 25, 2011, Student's former counsel withdrew the matter along with her notice of withdrawal of representation. Parent filed a request to reopen the case on the grounds that withdrawal of the matter was not authorized by Parent, and on March 9, 2011, OAH granted Student's request to reopen. The continuance order of February 22, 2011, remains in effect and the 45 day time line to render a decision remains tolled. After discussion with Parent and District, the matter is set as follows:

1. The prehearing conference in this matter shall take place on April 13, 2011, at 10:00 A.M.
2. The due process hearing in this matter shall take place on April 26 and 27, 2011, at 9:30 A.M.
