ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
PHC/HRG

On April 18, 2011, the parties filed a stipulated request to continue the PHC and hearing dates on the ground that they wished to review IEE reports during further settlement negotiations. The request will be granted. Although the request mentioned a desire for further mediation, no agreed upon date was given. If the parties want to go to mediation, they should contact OAH to request mediation at a mutually agreed date and time.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332 .) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is:
