ORDER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
EVIDENCE AND BRIEFING ON
MOTION FOR STAY PUT

On March 11, 2011, Student filed a motion for stay put. On March 6, 2011, the District filed an opposition to the motion. On March 11, 2011, Student filed a reply to the District's opposition. The area of dispute is whether certain specified services were being provided as compensatory education as part of a settlement entered by the parties in a previous filed due process matter (OAH Case No. 2010071039) or was part of an IEP dated September 24, 2011. Additional information is required before a ruling may be made on the pleadings.

ORDER

Within five days of this order, each party shall provide a copy of the SEPTEMBER 24, 2010 IEP. If either party so desires, they may also file a written brief no longer than three pages explaining their position as to whether the services in issue were compensatory or included as part of the offer of a free appropriate education by the District.
