ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR
CHANGE OF VENUE

In February 2011, Student filed a due process hearing request naming the San Francisco Unified School District (District). On February 22, 2011, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued an order scheduling the hearing for the District offices located at 555 Franklin Street, San Francisco, California.

On April 6, 2011, OAH conducted a telephonic prehearing conference with counsel for the parties. After that prehearing conference, OAH issued an order confirming the hearing location to be 555 Franklin Street, San Francisco, California.

On Friday, April 15, 2011, two business days before the start of the hearing on Tuesday, April 19, 2011, the District filed a request to change the venue of the hearing. The District wishes to move the hearing location away from the Franklin street address and to alternate between two different addresses on different days of the hearing. During a telephone conversation with OAH staff, Student's counsel indicated that Student opposes the motion.

The District's request to change venue is DENIED. The hearing will remain at the Franklin Street address previously noticed in the OAH scheduling order and the prehearing conference order.
