ORDER GRANTING PEREMPTORY
CHALLENGE

On April 13, 2011, Student, through the attorney of record, filed a peremptory challenge to ALJ Stella Owens-Murrell prior to the prehearing conference.

A party is entitled to one peremptory challenge (disqualification without cause) to an ALJ assigned to an Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) hearing. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subs. (a) & (b); Gov. Code, § 11425.40, subd. (d).) Any challenge to the assigned ALJ shall be made no later than commencement of the prehearing conference. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subd. (c).)

Student's peremptory challenge is timely made and is granted pursuant to Government section 11425.40, subdivisions (a) and (d), and California Code of Regulations, title 1, section 1034, subdivision (c). ALJ Glynda Gomez is now the assigned ALJ for all purposes.
