ORDER GRANTING CHANGE OF
HEARING LOCATION

On May 25, 2011, Parent submitted a motion to change location of the due process hearing scheduled for August 29, 30, 31 and September 1, 2011 at District's offices. On June 7, 2011, District filed an opposition.

Under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) and state law, hearings must be conducted at a time and place that is reasonably convenient to the parents and child involved. (34 C.F.R. §300.515(d); Ed. Code, §56505(b).) Due process hearings are generally scheduled at either the school district office, the office of the Special Education Local Plan Area to which the District belongs, or a regional office of OAH.

Here, District's opposition demonstrates that parent lives closer to OAH than the District's offices and that the District office is only 11 miles from OAH. Thus, the OAH offices are reasonably convenient for the parent and are an appropriate hearing location. Accordingly, the motion to change the hearing location to the OAH office located at 2349 Gateway Oaks Drive, suite 200, Sacramento, California, 95833 is granted.
