ORDER GRANTING JOINT REQUEST
FOR CONTINUANCE AND SETTING
NEW PREHEARING CONFERENCE
AND DUE PROCESS HEARING
DATES

On April 1, 2011, Student and the Grossmont Union High School District filed a joint request to continue the dates in this matter.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3).) Speedy resolution of the due process hearing is mandated by law and continuance of the hearing may be granted only upon a showing of good cause. (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f)(3).) In ruling upon a motion for continuance, OAH is guided by the provisions found within the Administrative Procedure Act and the California Rules of Court that concern motions to continue. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

The Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is:

Granted. All dates are vacated. Since the parties did not propose a time for the telephonic prehearing conference, OAH has scheduled the matter for 1:30 p.m. Additionally, the parties have requested that the hearing be held on a Monday. It is OAH policy to begin hearings at 1:30 p.m. when they are scheduled to begin on a Monday. For this reason, OAH has calendared two days for the hearing in order to ensure that the matter is fully heard.

Mediation:	To be scheduled at a later date if parties request it.
Telephonic Prehearing Conference:	June 13, 2011, at 1:30 p.m. OAH will initiate the call.
Due Process Hearing:	June 20 - 21, 2011, starting at 1:30 p.m. on June 20.
