ORDER GRANTING PEREMPTORY  
CHALLENGE

On April 14, 2011, Student filed a peremptory challenge to disqualify Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Elsa H. Jones from hearing this case.

A party is entitled to one peremptory challenge (disqualification without cause) to an ALJ assigned to an Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) hearing. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subs. (a) & (b); Gov. Code, § 11425.40, subd. (d).) The challenge must be made no later than commencement of that prehearing conference. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subd. (c).)

Student's peremptory challenge is timely made and is granted pursuant to Government section 11425.40, subdivisions (a) and (d), and California Code of Regulations, title 1, section 1034, subdivision (c).

ALJ Stella Owens-Murrell is now assigned for the prehearing conference and hearing.
