ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO
VACATE DATES; ORDER
SCHEDULING STATUS
CONFERENCE

On April 13, 2011, Student filed a request to vacate all pending dates in this matter and to schedule a trial setting conference, based upon the parties' settlement of the case at resolution session. Student included a copy of the signature page from the settlement along with her request. Student indicates that the settlement agreement is contingent upon approval by the District's School Board, which is scheduled to meet on May 5, 2011. Student requests that a trial setting conference be scheduled after that date.

Good cause appearing, Student's request is granted with modification. All pending dates in this matter are vacated. It is the policy of the Office of Administrative Hearings to hold status conferences in matters where a settlement agreement is pending approval by a district's School Board, as is the situation in this case. A telephonic status conference is therefore scheduled for **May 11, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.** Should the District's School Board fail to approve the settlement agreement, the parties shall be prepared to discuss scheduling dates for the hearing during the status conference. OAH will initiate the call.
