ORDER FOLLOWING STATUS  
CONFERENCE

On May 4, 2011, a Telephonic Status Conference (TSC) was held, pursuant to an April 19, 2011 order by the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), before Administrative Law Judge, Bob N. Varma, OAH, Special Education Division. Dr. Rosalie Toren, advocate, appeared on behalf of Student. Jennifer R. Rowe, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the West Contra Costa Unified School District (District).

The TSC was called in order to address a pending motion by District requesting dismissal of this matter because Student had failed to serve District with the complaint. At the TSC, District confirmed that it had received a copy of Student's complaint on May 4, 2011, and no longer sought dismissal on that ground.

OAH confirmed that Dr. Toren is representing Student in this matter. Her information will be added to the service list for OAH. Ms. Rowe will file a Notice of Representation and her information will also be added to the service list. Dr. Toren was notified that she needs to serve all documents she files with OAH upon Ms. Rowe's office.

1. The complaint in this matter is deemed filed on the date of this order.
2. The 45-day time line for issuance of a decision is reset.
3. OAH will issue a new scheduling order.
