ORDER FOLLOWING STATUS
CONFERENCE

On September 14, 2011, a telephonic status conference (TSC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Bob N. Varma, Office of Administrative Hearings, Special Education Division (OAH). Kathryn Dobel, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Lenore Silverman, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the San Mateo Union High School District (District). The TSC was not recorded.

Based on discussion of the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

Submission of Supplementary Documents: This matter has reached a full and final settlement. As a term of the settlement, District is required to fund a special needs trust for Student, the final payment to which is due in 2012. Student contends that pursuant to a California Superior Court order in a separate action concerning Student, the parties were ordered to maintain this case before OAH until District provides the final funds in 2012. Student is ordered to submit a copy of the court order within one week of the date of this order. OAH will then determine if this case should be dismissed on OAH's own motion and will provide the parties with a briefing schedule.
