On April 26, 2011, the parties filed a joint stipulated request to continue all dates in this matter to mutually agreed dates, including multiple hearing dates, in the near future.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is granted. However, because the parties have stipulated to dates during the summer months, further continuances will not be granted on the ground of District witness unavailability. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows: Mediation – June 14, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.; Prehearing Conference – July 6, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.; Due Process Hearing – July 18-21, 25-28, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. on July 18 & 25, 2011 and 9:30 a.m. all other days.
