ORDER GRANTING STUDENT'S
MOTION TO DISMISS ISSUES ONE
AND TWO OF AMENDED DUE
PROCESS COMPLAINT WITH
PREJUDICE

On July 20, 2011, Student, through her Educational Rights Holder (hereafter Student), filed a motion to dismiss Issues one and two of her amended due process complaint, which Student filed on June 29, 2011. The basis for Student's motion to dismiss is that the parties reached a final settlement agreement resolving all matters related to Issues one and two. Student provided a copy of the signed signature page of the settlement agreement along with her motion. The Torrance Unified School District has not filed an opposition to Student's motion.
