ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 29, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., Elsa H. Jones, Administrative Law Judge, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), convened a telephonic hearing pursuant to the Order to Show Cause (OSC) re: Dismissal issued in this matter on August 17, 2011. Student's father (Parent) appeared on behalf of himself and Student. District, which was self-represented, did not appear. Prior to commencing the hearing, the ALJ called the District's office, but the ALJ was directed only to an automated telephone system and was unable to speak to any person at the District. No party filed any response to the OSC re: Dismissal.

The proceedings were recorded.

During the hearing, Parent requested dismissal of the due process hearing request (Complaint), on the ground that the District had provided Student with all of the relief requested in the Complaint, and further on the ground that the Student no longer attends school in the District.

Accordingly, the matter is DISMISSED, without prejudice.
