ORDER GRANTING/DENYING
REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE AND
SETTING MED/TSC/PHC/HRG

On May 23, 2011, the parties filed a request to continue all dates in the above matter. The dates requested would have put the PHC before the mediation, and requested a single hearing date on a Monday, when OAH does not schedule hearings prior to 1:30 p.m. In light of the above, although the request will be granted, the dates and times have been adjusted to have mediation occur prior to hearing activities, to add an additional hearing day in light of the issues presented, and to conform to OAH calendaring requirements.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is:
