ORDER DENYING MOTION TO
CONSOLIDATE WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On April 22, 2011, District filed a Request for Due Process Hearing in OAH case number 2011040863 (First Case), naming Student as the respondent.

On May 17, 2011, Student filed a Request for Due Process Hearing in OAH case number 2011050741 (Second Case), naming District as the respondent.

On May 17, 2011, Student filed a Motion to Consolidate the First Case with the Second Case.

On May 20, 2011, District filed a Notice of Non-Opposition.

Although the First Case and Second Case involve common question of law or fact, and consolidation would further the interests of judicial economy, the motion is denied without prejudice. Neither the First Case nor the Second Case are currently scheduled for a sufficient number of days to conclude the hearing in the consolidated matters. The parties did not meet and confer regarding hearing dates as is requested by OAH. The parties may re-submit the request to consolidate and continue these cases after they have agreed upon sufficient hearing dates.

ORDER

Student's Motion to Consolidate is denied without prejudice.
