ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE AND

On July 15, 2011, following a prehearing conference on July 13, 2011, the parties filed a stipulated joint request for a one month continuance of the hearing dates to further pursue settlement. The parties further requested that one of the current hearing dates be used to conduct a settlement conference.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is:

Granted. All dates are vacated. No further continuances are contemplated as the parties have had adequate time for settlement negotiations. This matter will be set as follows, at OAH, 15350 Sherman Way, suite 300, Van Nuys, CA, 91406:
