ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
MED/PHC/HRG

On June 17, 2011, the parties filed a stipulated first request to continue the hearing date to a mutually agreed date in the future.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is:

Granted. All dates are vacated. However, when requesting a continuance, the parties are expected to request hearing dates that they estimate are sufficient to address the issue raised in the complaint and on dates consistent with OAH scheduling practices. **Additional hearing dates were added to the request based on the allegations, and the mediation date was changed.** This matter will be set as follows:
