ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
ADDITIONAL PAGES FOR WRITTEN
CLOSING ARGUMENT

On July 3, 2012, Student's counsel filed a request to change the page limit set for written closing argument from 30 pages to 35 pages. The District opposed the request on the basis that the request was made only one business day before the written closing argument is due. If the request is granted, the District asks that the date for filing written closing argument be extended to Monday, July 9, 2012.

Student's request for additional pages is granted. Both parties may file a written closing argument no longer than 35 pages.

The District's request for an extension of time for filing the written closing argument is denied. The due date and time will remain as currently set. Both parties are reminded that a short, succinct brief can be just as persuasive as a lengthy brief.
