ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR
CHANGE OF MEDIATION
LOCATION

On June 27, 2011, Student filed a Due Process Request (complaint) naming Vista Unified School District (District) and SAITECH, a charter school, as respondents. In the complaint, Student contended that she was then a resident of the JOB Corps in Long Beach, California, where her education was provided by SAITECH, a school chartered by the District.

On October 7, 2011, Student filed a motion to change the location of the mediation from Vista, California to the Los Angeles office of the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) because Student resides in Los Angeles and relies on public transportation. Student contends that she will be unable to attend the mediation as scheduled.

Neither respondent has filed an opposition to Student's motion.

Good cause being demonstrated, Student's motion to change the location of mediation is granted. The mediation will be held at the Los Angeles office of OAH, 320 West Fourth Street, Suite 630, Los Angeles, CA 90013, on November 18, 2011 commencing at 10:00 a.m...
