ORDER FOR BRIEFING ON POST-
HEARING PROCEDURE

On September 23, 2011, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) from the Office of Administrative Hearings, Special Education Division, conducted a telephonic Status Conference in this matter. Mother represented Student, and attorney Justin Shinnefield represented the San Dieguito Union High School District in the Status Conference. The purpose of the conference was to discuss the procedure to follow given the fact that the ALJ who presided at the due process hearing in this matter is medically unavailable and is not expected to return to his duties at OAH for two months.

The parties may provide written briefs on the preferred procedure to follow.
