ORDER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL  
INFORMATION ON MOTION TO  
DISMISS

On July 19, 2011, the Tamalpais Union High School District (District) filed a motion to dismiss, asserting that Student did not serve a copy of the request for a due process hearing (complaint) on the District. Student did not file a response. Additional information is required before a ruling may be made on the pleadings, as the District did not include a declaration from a District official to establish that it did not receive a copy of Student's complaint. Additionally, while Student's complaint indicates that he served a copy of complaint, the complaint is not clear if he served the District or Marin County Office of Education (MCOE).

ORDER

By 5:00 p.m. on August 2, 2011, the District shall provide a sworn declaration about whether it received a copy of Student's complaint and Student shall inform the Office of Administrative Hearings and the District if his complaint is against the District, MCOE or both.
