ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO
DISMISS

On August 10, 2011, Roberta S. Savage, on behalf of Student filed a request for extension of time until August 22, 2011, to file opposition to the Cabrillo Unified School District's (District) motion to dismiss the first cause of action in Student's complaint. District has filed no response to this request.

District's motion to dismiss the first cause of action is significant and is composed of a five-page motion, a two-page declaration and two exhibits composed of 16 pages. Student's counsel has explained in a letter that she has a pre-planned vacation scheduled between August 12 and August 17, 2011 and does not have adequate time to oppose District's motion prior to beginning her vacation. Student's counsel requests that the three days allowed for response be placed at the end of her vacation. Balancing the importance of the motion to Student against any prejudice to the District, the motion shall be granted. However, in future requests Student's counsel is advised to provide a declaration when making her request.

The request for extension of to file opposition to District's motion to dismiss is granted. Any opposition] shall be filed by August 22, 2011.
