ORDER DENYING STUDENT'S  
MOTION TO RECUSE COUNSEL

PARENT ON BEHALF OF STUDENT.

On October 19, 2011, Student filed a motion to disqualify legal counsel for the Victor Valley Union High School District (District), Desert Mountain Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA), and San Bernardino County Superintendent's Office (Superintendent's Office) from representing these parties in this matter. On October 24, 2011, the District, SELPA, and Superintendent's Office filed an opposition.

Student's motion does not set forth any legal authority that the Office of Administrative Hearings can disqualify the legal counsel of the District, SELPA, and Superintendent's Office. Additionally, Student's motion contains hearsay evidence and is designed primarily to harass the District, SELPA, and Superintendent's Office and delay this matter. Therefore, Student's motion to disqualify the legal counsel of the District, SELPA, and Superintendent's Office is denied.
