ORDER ON "REQUEST FOR
CLARIFICATION OF STAY PUT"

On September 8, 2011, Student filed a motion for stay put. On September 16, 2011, the undersigned administrative law judge (ALJ) issued an order granting Student's motion, finding that it had not been opposed by District. On September 16, 2011, District filed a motion for reconsideration, contending that it had, on September 13, 2011, filed an opposition to the motion that had not been considered. On September 16, 2011, after reviewing District's arguments, the undersigned ALJ granted District's motion for reconsideration and ruled that the motion for stay put, which had previously been granted, was now denied. Thus, there is no stay put order currently in effect.

On September 30, 2011, Student filed a "Request For Clarification Of Stay Put" that sought clarification of District's stay put obligations under the ALJ's prior orders. However, there is no stay put order currently in effect.

Should Student so intend it may file a new Motion for Stay Put, which District will then be given an opportunity to oppose.

ORDER

There is currently no stay put order in effect.
