ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND  
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On December 19, 2011, counsel for the Garden Grove Unified School District filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a request to continue the hearing dates set after the filing of the amended complaint in this matter. The request is based largely upon the fact that the current hearing dates fall within the holiday break, that witnesses will not be available, and that more time is needed for the hearing. Student has not filed a response to this request.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3).) Speedy resolution of the due process hearing is mandated by law and continuance of the hearing may be granted only upon a showing of good cause. (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f)(3).)
