ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
TRIAL SETTING CONFERENCE

On August 29, 2011, counsel for the Tustin Unified School District (District) filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings a request to continue the initially scheduled hearing dates in this matter. On August 31, 2011, counsel for Student filed with OAH a request to continue the dates. On September 1, 2011, counsel for the District filed with OAH a response to Student's request for a continuance, indicating that the District did not oppose Student's motion.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3).) Speedy resolution of the due process hearing is mandated by law and continuance of the hearing may be granted only upon a showing of good cause. (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f)(3).)

OAH has reviewed the separate requests for good cause and the requests are:
