ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR

On October 3, 2011, Parent filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a motion to continue the currently scheduled hearing dates in the case. The motion is a second request for a continuance based upon the need to obtain counsel. On October 4, 2011, counsel for the District filed an opposition to the request. This will be the last continuance request granted in order to allow Parent to obtain representation in the case.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3).) Speedy resolution of the due process hearing is mandated by law and continuance of the hearing may be granted only upon a showing of good cause. (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f)(3).)
