ORDER GRANTING PEREMPTORY
CHALLENGE

On November 16, 2011, Student timely filed a peremptory challenge to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Deborah Myers-Cregar.

A party is entitled to one peremptory challenge (disqualification without cause) to an ALJ assigned to an Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) hearing. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subs. (a) & (b); Gov. Code, § 11425.40, subd. (d).) Any challenge to the assigned ALJ shall be made no later than commencement of that prehearing conference. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subd. (c).)

Student's peremptory challenge is timely made and is granted. ALJ Darrell Lepkowsky is now assigned to the PHC and hearing.
