ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On February 22, 2012, a prehearing conference (PHC) was held in this matter before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Gary A. Geren. ALJ Geren issued an Order Following Prehearing Conference, which set forth all matters discussed in the PHC, including hearing dates and times, the issues to be litigated, and orders concerning witnesses, evidence, hearing setting, amongst others. On February 24, 2012, the undersigned issued an order that continued the hearing dates in this matter. That order specifically set forth the continued dates and times for hearing.

On April 10, 2012, the Dry Creek Joint Elementary School District (District) filed a request for a prehearing conference and set forth proposed dates. District noted that it had been unable to gain agreement from Student as to a specific date. On April 13, 2012, Parent, on behalf of Student, filed a response which set forth a different proposed date for a PHC. What both parties failed to address is why a second PHC is necessary, in light of the complete PHC order by ALJ Geren. The parties fail to identify any outstanding matters which would necessitate another PHC. Accordingly, the request for another PHC is denied.
