ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR
TRIAL SETTING CONFERENCE

On March 26, 2012, the Lucia Mar Unified School District (District) and the San Luis Obispo County Office of Education (County) filed a request for a trial setting conference (TSC) on the grounds that their expert witnesses are unavailable on the date(s) of the currently scheduled due process hearing. The Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) will set a TSC under special circumstances, which are not present in this matter.

However, District and County are encouraged to meet and confer with Parents as to mutually agreeable dates. If the parties are successful, they may file a joint request to continue setting out those dates. If they are unsuccessful, either party may move for a continuance, stating that they were unsuccessful in their attempt to meet and confer, and setting out good cause for their requested continuance. OAH will timely rule on such a motion.
