ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On October 27, 2011, counsel for Saddleback Valley Unified School District filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings a request to continue the initially scheduled hearing dates in the case, based upon the District's calendar and counsel's unavailability through December 2011. On October 31, 2011, counsel for Student filed an opposition to this request, requesting a one week continuance of the due process hearing.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3).) Speedy resolution of the due process hearing is mandated by law and continuance of the hearing may be granted only upon a showing of good cause. (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f)(3).)
