ORDER GRANTING IN PART  
REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE OF  
PHC

On November 16, 2011, the parties filed a joint request to continue the PHC to the date of hearing on the ground that they needed additional time to obtain signatures on a settlement agreement.

OAH will not take hearing dates “off calendar.” In essence, that is what the parties are seeking by asking to move the PHC to the day of hearing without offering any other proposed hearing date. Moreover, if, as the parties have represented, they only need to obtain signatures, they have had ample time to do so already, and by this order will have an additional three days. Accordingly, although the PHC will be rescheduled, it will only be moved to Monday, **November 21, 2011 at 1:30 p.m.** The parties have until the close of business on Friday, November 18, 2011, to submit a withdrawal of the due process hearing request or PHC statements.
