MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION

On October 10, 2011, Parents on behalf of Student (Student) filed a Due Process hearing Request and Motion for Stay Put. In his stay put motion, Student requests an order setting BII and BID services as stay put pursuant to a settlement agreement and implemented IEP. The Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued an order granting Student's stay put motion on October 19, 2011. On October 24, 2011, Student filed a motion to clarify the October 19, 2011 order as to where the BII and BID services would be provided pursuant to the last implemented IEP and the settlement agreement.
