ORDER GRANTING STUDENT'S
REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF IEP
DOCUMENT

On November 7, 2011, the El Dorado Union High School District (District) filed a Due Process Request (complaint) naming parents on behalf of Student (Student) as respondents. The complaint seeks an order that the actions of the District IEP team placing Student at an alternative education setting and the IEP of October 18, 2011 were appropriate.

Student has filed a motion to dismiss and several addendums to the motion as well as two requests for reconsideration. In each of these pleadings, Student avers that he has never received any written evidence that an IEP team meeting occurred on October 18, 2011. Student's request for copies of the October 18, 2011 IEP document which is contained in the Student's second motion for reconsideration filed on November 28, 2011, is now deemed a motion for education records.

Student has a right to a copy of his educational records. Student's motion to receive a copy of the October 18, 2011 IEP document is GRANTED.

ORDER

1. The District shall serve upon Student a complete copy of the October 18, 2011 IEP document within four days of the date of this order.

2. In the event that Student desires further education records, he shall present the request in writing to the District complying with District procedures regarding such requests.
