ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING
PHC/HRG

On February 1, 2012, the parties filed a stipulated request for a second continuance of the PHC and hearing on the ground of attorney scheduling conflict and desire to conduct additional assessments as part of settlement discussions.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is Granted. All dates are vacated. However, no further continuances will be granted, as the parties will have had ample time for settlement discussions and additional assessments and the attorneys are representing they are available on the agreed dates. This matter will be set as follows:

after.
