ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE GRANTING LEAVE  
TO FILE AMENDED COMPLAINT

Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Robert Helfand held a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) in this matter on January 30, 2012. Margaret J. McNair, Attorney at Law, represented Parent on behalf of Student (Student). Cynthia Yount, Attorney at Law, represented the Charter Oaks Unified School District (District). Courtney M. Brady, Attorney at law, represented the Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE). The PHC was not recorded.

On January 30, 2012, Student filed with OAH a proposed amended complaint. At the PHC, Student moved for leave to file the amended complaint. The District and LACOE did not oppose Student's motion. Good cause being demonstrated, Student's motion for leave to file the amended complaint is GRANTED. OAH will issue a new scheduling order based upon the date of filing of the amended complaint.
