ORDER RESETTING TIMELINE
AFTER FILING OF FIRST AMENDED
COMPLAINT

On December 7, 2011, OAH conducted a prehearing conference (PHC) in this matter. On motion of the Panama-Buena Vista Union School District (District), OAH continued the PHC on the original complaint to February 15, 2011, and the due process hearing on that complaint to February 22 and 23, 2011. On December 9, 2011, OAH partially granted a Notice of Insufficiency directed to the original complaint and granted the District 14 days to amend its complaint.

On December 19, 2011, the District filed a first amended complaint. By operation of law the filing of the first amended complaint restarts the timeline for decision. (20 U.S.C. § 1415(c)(2)(E)(ii).) Accordingly, all dates previously set in this matter are vacated. OAH has today issued a scheduling order re-calendaring the matter. The parties may seek a continuance for good cause shown.
