ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO
RESET TIMELINES

On January 5, 2012, Student's parent, acting on behalf of Student (Student), filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a due process hearing request (complaint) naming the San Diego Unified School District (District) as the respondent.

On January 11, 2012, the District filed a motion to reset the timelines for the case. Student has not responded to that motion.

The basis for the District's motion is that the District first received a copy of Student's complaint when OAH provided the document to the District on January 11, 2012.

ORDER

1. The District's motion to reset procedural timelines is granted.
2. All previously set dates in this matter are vacated.
3. The timelines for hearing shall recommence as of January 11, 2012.
