BRIEFING ON MOTION FOR STAY  
PUT

On February 21, 2012, Student filed a Motion for Stay Put against the Salinas Union High School District (District) and Monterey County Mental Health (MCMH), which requested that Student remain in her last agreed upon and implemented educational program and that the District and MCMH not exit Student from special education services. Neither the District nor MCMH filed a response. Additional information is required before a ruling may be made on the pleadings.

ORDER

Within five days of this order, each party shall provide a copy of Student's last agreed upon and implemented educational program. Each party shall include sworn declarations supporting any factual assertions included in its briefing.
