ORDER REGARDING DISTRICT'S
MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

On April 3, 2012, the Fresno Unified School District (District) filed a motion for a protective order that sought to preclude Student from subpoenaing to testify four named District employees. The District submitted supplemental information on April 5, 2012, and Student submitted an opposition on April 6, 2012. The District filed its motion based upon the originally set Prehearing Conference (PHC) date of April 4, 2012, and hearing date of April 12, 2012. On April 3, 2012, the Office of Administrative Hearings granted the District's motion to continue, and set the PHC for May 7, 2012, and the hearing for May 15 – 17, 2012. Therefore, the parties are ordered to meet and confer before the May 7, 2012 PHC as to the witnesses listed in their respective PHC statements, and be prepared to discuss at the May 7, 2012 PHC the District's motion for protective order if Student still requests that the four named individuals testify at hearing.
