AMENDED ORDER GRANTING
STUDENT'S REQUEST TO HOLD IEP
MEETING BY MAY 22, 2012

On April 20, 2012, Parent on behalf of Student (Student) filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a due process request (complaint) and motion for stay put. The Oakland Unified School District (District) did not file an opposition. On May 7, 2012, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued an order granting Student's motion for stay put ordering Student to remain placed at the True Life Center/Journey High School (TLC). Additionally, the order provided, "In the event that Student is asked to leave True Life Center/Journey High School, the District will hold an IEP meeting to place Student in a residential treatment center which provides similar services as provided by True Life Center/Journey High School."

On May 16, 2012, Student filed a Request for an Order to Hold an IEP Meeting on May 17, 2012. Student attaches to her request a May 3, 2012 letter from Paula Solomon, clinical director of TLC, which informs Student's mother that TLC will no longer allow Student to remain at TLC. On May 16, 2012, The District filed a response to Student's motion.

Having considered the parties' contentions and OAH's May 7, 2012 order, Student's motion for the District to conduct an IEP team meeting is GRANTED and the IEP team meeting shall be held by May 22, 2012 in order to place Student in a residential treatment center which provides similar services as were provided by TLC.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
