ORDER DENYING STUDENT'S
AMENDED MOTION FOR STAY PUT

On May 2, 2012, Parent on behalf of Student (Student) filed a request for due process hearing (complaint) naming the San Dieguito Union High School District (District) as respondent. On May 2, 2012, Student filed a motion for stay put. Also on May 2, 2012, the District filed an opposition to the stay put motion as well as a Notice of Insufficiency. On May 2, 2012, OAH issued an order partially granting Student's motion for stay put. On May 3, 2012, the office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued an order determining the sufficiency of the complaint.

On May 4, 2012, Student filed a motion for reconsideration of OAH's May 2, 2012 order partially granting the motion for stay put and submitted documents in support of his position. On May 9, 2012, the District filed an opposition to Student's amended motion for stay put. Also on May 9, 2012, OAH issued an order denying Student's motion for reconsideration. On May 15, 2012, Student filed a reply to the District's opposition to the amended motion for stay put.

Student's amended motion for stay put was actually the submission of documents to support its motion for reconsideration. Thus, the amended motion for stay put is moot as OAH's order denying the motion for reconsideration dealt with Student's amended motion for stay put.

Accordingly, Student's amended motion for stay put is moot is DENIED as moot.
