On October 2, 2012, OAH issued an order requesting that Student file copies of two unpublished federal court documents (one order and one tentative ruling) that had been cited in Student's written closing argument. Student filed those documents on October 3, 2012. According to Student's written closing argument, the United States District Court should be issuing a final order (in place of its tentative ruling) on or about October 11, 2012.

On October 5, 2012, the Garden Grove Unified School District (District) requested an opportunity to file a supplemental briefing regarding those two federal cases. Good cause exists to grant the District's request and to toll the due date for the decision in this matter by one week to allow for filing of a supplemental briefing. This supplemental briefing period will also benefit both parties by giving the federal court an opportunity to make a final order rather than a tentative decision.

By close of business on Monday, October 15, 2012, either party may (but is not required to) file and serve a supplemental briefing. The supplemental briefing shall address the two federal court documents filed with OAH by Student on October 3, 2012, and how those federal court documents relate to the issue of meaningful, informed consent that was raised in the District's due process hearing request. The supplemental briefing shall be no longer than 10 pages.

ORDER

1. On or before close of business on Monday, October 15, 2012, either party or both parties may file by fax with OAH and serve on the other party a supplemental briefing regarding the two federal documents filed by Student with OAH on October 3, 2012.

2.. If, prior to the date the supplemental briefing is due, a final order is issued in place of the tentative ruling by the United States District Court in *J.L. v. Downey Unified School District*, case number CV 12-2285-GW(SSx), Student shall file with OAH a copy of that order (with appropriate redaction of any personal information regarding the child or the child's family).

3. The supplemental briefing shall be no longer than 10 pages, not counting copies of any federal court order(s) that might be attached.

4. The due date for the decision herein will be tolled by one week to accommodate the supplemental briefing.
