On July 5, 2012, Parent, on behalf of Student, submitted to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a request to continue the initially scheduled mediation and hearing dates in this matter, citing a family vacation, and stating that the family can attend to this matter after July 30, 2012. On July 11, 2012, counsel for the Oakland Unified School District filed with OAH a response, stating that the District petitioners do not oppose a brief continuance in the matter.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:
